

Because Periodontology is exactly this – a surgical application of pure biology. To be good in Perio means you need to be good in both.

I've achieved this myself by living for years fully immersed in Periodontology during my formative education years in London and Gothenburg. From my experience, an intention was born to create an educational campus, not a course, and a community that would be empowered to do Periodontology.

I've started this endeavour with a friend, a colleague and a worldwide known clinician and researcher, Cristiano Tomasi from Gothenburg with whom I share the same experiences, passion and vision of Periodontology. We've designed an intensive, full-immersion campus for professionals who cannot afford, in time or money, to spend years abroad or within a specialty training. We've started in 2012, and 7 years down the road we're probably the most successful course in Periodontology in Italy, with several international editions under our belt and more than 500 Periocampus Alumni.

Now, it's time for Zagreb. I'm looking forward to seeing and discussing Perio with all of you in May!"

WHAT MAKES PERIOCAMPUS DIFFERENT?

Periocampus is not a course in Periodontology.
Periocampus is **a full-immersion campus in Periodontology**.
There's certainly an academic ring to it, and for a reason, because Periocampus nurtures the immersive atmosphere one would usually experience at a university campus. Learning and dwelling deeper into Periodontology does not begin and end with each lecture.

The programme of Periocampus is designed in a way that **for 3** days, from the morning till the evening, **every element is given an educational purpose.** Even the meal-time and breaks are created so **you can learn in an untraditional atmosphere** and be exposed to information that will give you a more comprehensive outlook of Periodontology, the patient and periodontal treatment. **The main goal of Periocampus is to empower clinicians to apply what they've took from Periocampus the moment they get back to their patients in their dental practice.**

Due to its intense, immersive programme, Periocampus connects clinicians that share the same interest and passion for Periodontology - it builds a community.



Periocampus Foundation Croatia is the Module 1 of the Periocampus education. It's designed to give the knowledge and teach the manual skills to **understand**, **diagnose and treat periodontal cases with autonomy**.

While Module 1 is fully appropriate for those that are novel to Periodontology, it is also intended for experienced clinicians to build up on their knowledge and practice their dexterity through innovative and unique hands-on practicals of the **Periocampus method**. The programme focuses on diagnosis, treatment-planning and nonsurgical periodontal treatment around teeth and implants.

To make the learning process efficient, Periocampus teaching is founded on:

- Case-based interactive learning
- Innovative hands-on practical training (Periocampus method)
- Clinical, in-vivo practices

As both the etiology and the pathological impact of periodontitis extend far beyond the oral cavity, Periocampus addresses topics that will improve your clinical competence and may considerably influence the outcome of your treatment. By taking a step forward in education in Periodontology, Periocampus Foundation also teaches nutrition, stress management, patient motivation and the systemic impact of the disease. A unique session about the management of the periodontal patients in the private practice, as well as its marketing is part of the programme as well.
